### **Key facts**

- Makaton is a sign-based system designed to support understanding and expression in young children and those with speech, language and communication needs. It is not a formal or recognised language in its own right.
- Consistency is key! Ensure everyone in contact with the child uses the same sign to avoid confusion.
- Makaton is always used alongside the spoken word.
- Makaton signs are only used for the key words in a sentence.
- Makaton provides a visual representation of the speaker's meaning giving children more chance of understanding the word.
- Signs are fun and straightforward to do, giving even young children and babies a method of expression before they are ready to use the word. This reduces frustration for both the child and the parent!
- Makaton will not stop your child from using the word when they are ready. Once your child can say the word, they will naturally stop using the sign.

#### What is Makaton?

Makaton is a sign-based system used alongside the spoken word. It is designed to support understanding and expression in young children and those with speech, language and communication needs.

Makaton is not a formal or recognised language in its own right, unlike British Sign Language (BSL) for example. The speaker says and signs only the key words in the sentence.

### How can Makaton help my child?

- Signing the key words as you say them helps <u>focus the child's</u>
  <u>attention</u> on those words and gives another clue as to what the word
  might mean.
- Signing <u>helps slow down your rate of speech</u> naturally, thereby making what you say easier for the child to follow.
- The signs are usually very obvious, <u>helping your child understand the</u> meaning of the word.
- Before a child knows how to say a word, Makaton gives them <u>another</u> <u>mode of expression</u> that is easier and more achievable for them.
- Most signs are <u>straightforward</u> to do, even babies can do them!
- Makaton helps <u>reduce frustration</u> in young children as it gives them another way of expressing themselves and makes it easier for you to understand your child's wants and needs.
- The signs are <u>fun and engaging</u> catching your child's attention, while also raising their enjoyment and confidence in communicating!

Note: Makaton signs will not stop your child from using the word when they are ready. Once your child can say the word independently, they will naturally drop the sign!
